Dear Pastors:

We are attempting to provide scholarship monies to our Church School College Youth who meet the criteria below. In order to determine what students may be eligible for the scholarship, we need your help. We are asking that you forward to us the name, address, phone number of students in your church who meet criteria 1-7. If the student is an active participant of the Youth Congress, please indicate next to the students' name on the attached form. This information must be mailed to Mother Lillie Pease on or before April 1, 2011 to be considered.

### **CRITERIA:**

1. Must be enrolled and can show proof of enrollment in a vocational school, community college or university as a full-time student for Fall, 2011. Be classified as a sophomore, junior or senior or can demonstrate more than one year of full-time study at a vocational school.
2. Proof of continued and consistent study in a vocational, community college or university.
3. Verify at least a cumulative 2.0 or above overall grade point average.
4. Must be a regular church school participant in his/her local church. Verification of attendance in church school will be a must. Regular is defined as attendance at least twice a month in church school. The Pastor and Church School Superintendent must sign a statement verifying that the applicant attends church regular. A Verification Form is attached and must be submitted for each student.
5. The applicant must provide a short narrative of no more than 200 words on the December 19, 2010 Church School Lesson; "The Mission of a Servant." The narrative must be double spaced, one inch margins, with 12 pitch font.
6. Applicant must be affiliated with a Primitive Baptist Church of the Middle Florida-Georgia Association.

**7.The student will be asked to attend at least one session of the upcoming Church School Convention to be held at The Old West Enrichment**

**Center, Tallahassee,  
Florida.**

**8.The church must have contributed the amount assessed by the Church School Convention for Scholarship.**

**9.If the student is an active member or officer of the Middle Florida-Georgia youth Congress, please indicate on the attached form.**

**We will take the information you forward and provide your student(s) with an application and a list of supporting documentation needed to be considered for the scholarship.**

**I am providing a form for you to complete and return by April 1, 2011. Please keep in mind that the Verification of Church School Attendance Form mut also be submitted with the other forms. If we have not received your list of eligible student(s) and Verification Form for each student, postmarked on or before April 1, 2011, consideration will not be given for the 2011 Scholarship. Therefore, I suggest you review the criteria and if you have eligible students, please send the information to us as soon as possible. There will be no exceptions to the April 1 deadline.**
