Allen-Bartley-Frazier Scholarship Aid Guidelines - 2011

Objective: These guidelines are prepared with the anticipation of assisting those students, in need of financial assistance to further their education, who have achieved academically as well as those who have demonstrated potential for successful academic achievement.

This scholarship aid is for the current year graduating high school seniors to pursue a degree or certificate in order to become gainfully employed.

1. The applicant must be in good standing (morally, socially, educationally, etc) in their school and community, and in need of assistance to further their education. If the applicant does not attend a Florida school, the applicant's church must be a member of the Florida State Primitive Baptist Convention.
2. One thousand dollars (**\$1,000**) **per district of the Florida Public Schools** will be awarded for scholarships each year to a maximum of **seven qualified** applicants. If a district does not have an applicant, that \$1,000 will be awarded to another qualified applicant.
3. Each applicant must have at least an overall 2.5 GPA (unweighted) at the end of the last grading period and submit a transcript with the last grading period included with the application. The official GPA will be verified by the official transcript.
4. **The application packet must include and be postmarked no later than March 15:**
 - a. **Application completed online at www.fspbc.org and printed to get proper signatures or typed on the official form. Handwritten applications will not be considered.**
 - b. **An up-to-date resume**
 - c. **Letter or form verifying volunteer service (from Agency where service was performed)**
 - d. **Two letters of reference from non-relatives** (one from a school person—teacher, advisor, coach and one from another community adult)
 - e. **A one-page essay** – “How This Scholarship Will Assist My Financial Need” – double-spaced, 12-point, Times New Roman, 1” sides and bottom margins, 1.5” top margin.
5. The Scholarship Committee of the Florida State Primitive Baptist Foundation will screen applications and submit results to the Foundation, for approval, during the Annual Convention. **Upon receipt of verification of enrollment (at least 12 hours or equivalent) in an institution (paid registration receipt after classes begin)**, a request will be submitted to the Foundation for payment (June or August).
6. A student will receive only one scholarship aid.
7. All Awardees **must attend the Awards Banquet during the Florida State Primitive Baptist Youth Convention in Orlando, July 7-9, 2011**, during which awards will be presented. **Failure to attend the Youth Convention will result in forfeiture of the award.**
